#### **Academics**

This summer you are expected to read a collection of books in preparation for your upcoming English literature class. We will send you a list of summer reading books for you to purchase as soon as possible. These are the only books you should have delivered to your home address, or where you plan to be this summer. You will order all of the rest of your textbooks during the New Student Orientation in August.

We schedule students according to the classes you have already taken and the classes you need to graduate. Math will be decided in August when you arrive, as you will take a placement test during the orientation weeks.

#### **Orientation Overview**

After breakfast and room inspections, students begin the day with lessons to prepare them for Villanova's academic rigor. As boarding may be new for students, time will be taken to introduce the rules and procedures of the dorm life. Students will be introduced to the traditions that make our community unique.

The program will include trips to the beach, nearby universities, sporting events, museums, and service projects. Students may also begin summer practice with a fall team. ## You **NEED** the following items:

- pillows, blankets, bedspread, pillow cases, Twin XL size sheets (75" x 39")
- towels
- reading lamp, non-halogen
- clothing/clothes hangers

- clock
- toiletries, bath soap, shower basket, etc.
- laundry bag/basket and laundry soap, etc.
- school supplies (paper, pens, pencils, binders, calculator, etc.)
- water bottle
- flip flop/sandals for the shower.

### You are **PERMITTED** to have the following items:

- personal cup, bowl
- blow dryer/ curling iron
- personal computer/ laptop
- bicycle & helmet (required under age 18 California Law)
- automobile (refer to handbook)
- cellular telephone (refer to handbook)

### You are **PROHIBITED** to have the following items:

- hot pots, hot plates, coffee makers, toasters, and any other cooking equipment
- irons without automatic shut-offs
- television sets, DVD/Blue Ray, etc. players
- Motorcycles, mopeds, skateboards, and/or scooters
- Air conditioners
- Refrigerators
- Tobacco, tobacco products, matches, lighters, vaping products
- Pornographic materials
- Pirated movies and music or other copyrighted materials
- Alcohol
- Weapons: knives, box cutters, guns, toy guns, etc.
